ThorNton Creek plays original songs in the Americana tradition: country, folk, and rock, with dashes of blues and jazz for flavor. Energetic music with creative melodies and insightful lyrics.

For over 20 years the band has been playing for audiences from Seattle to Nashville, in clubs, festivals, hoedowns, and private events. Their music has been used in films and covered by other bands. Thornton Creek has released 5 full length recordings to date, with more always in the works. The members of Thornton Creek enjoy playing together and it shows.

Songwriter Thornton Bowman grew up in the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains, an influence heard in his voice and lyrical references to times past and present. Thornton sings and plays guitar. Don Miller (lead guitar) and Mark Drake (drums) sing harmony. Randy Rush plays Hammond and piano, and Steve Miller plays bass. Together they collaborate on arrangements and ideas for Thornton's songs, giving them a richness and life that is uniquely Thornton Creek.
